DAY 4. SUNDAY, OCT 20 , 2019 - LEAVE ACCRA FOR CAPE COAST - DOOR OF NO RETURN

- Cape Coast was once the capital of the Gold Coast, and it is known for the slaveholders' fortresses:
 Cape Coast Castle and Elmina Castle.
- * Fifty years in the building, Cape Coast Castle was originally made of wood and was built by the Swedish Africa Company for trade in gold and timber. Later rebuilt in stone, it was seized by the Danish, then the British. It became the seat of the colonial British Gold Coast. During the slave trade, enslaved Africans were held in the wretched dungeons of the castle as they awaited the Middle Passage.
- Elmina Slave castle is the oldest fortress of the slave trade in West Africa. It was built in 1482 by the Portuguese. It was captured by the Dutch and served in trade with Brazil and the Caribbean; the British later held it.
- * The castles reverberate with the captives' cries as they endured the torture and cruelties inflicted on them. Be part of honoring the spirits of the Ancestors as we tour the slave dungeons and pass through the Door of No Return, the last point before Africans were forced onto the ships.





TRIP PROTECTION INSURANCE

Tour participants may obtain TRIP PROTECTION INSURANCE. This coverage will protect against trip cancellation, loss of luggage, and medical emergency. We strongly recommend travel insurance. Information regarding trip protection insurance is available upon request.

TRAVEL INFORMATION

At the Pre-travel Orientation, Nana Kweku will go over many matters with you about traveling to Ghana, West Africa. Here are some quick reference points.

INOCULATIONS: Ghana requires Yellow Fever inoculation for entry into the country. Please consult with your physician regarding any medical concerns prior to booking your place on the tour.

LUGGAGE: Only two pieces of luggage may be checked in (max. 50 lbs.) and one small-size piece weighing a maximum of 15 lbs. may be carried on the flight. The airlines are very strict about this luggage requirement. The cost for weight overage is exorbitant. Pack wisely. Shop wisely. Be careful of possible overweight coming back to the US.

MARKET PLACE: Paying the original asking price or first price is a gift to the seller. Bargain or barter for what you want remembering that people are trying to support their families.

DRINKING WATER: Drinking bottled water is advised on these tours. Bottled water can be purchased from local stores near the hotels; this is less expensive than doing so at the hotels. We will also offer drinking water.

MALARIA PILLS: If you are taking the weekly pills, the medication hould be taken once a week on the same day that you started taking them until the supply is exhausted. Please be conscientious.

TRAVEL COURTESY: Please be on time for all tour travels. Lateness inconveniences the entire group.

CURRENCY, CREDIT CARDS, CELL PHONES, AND FINAL NOTES We will go over this in detail at the Pre-travel Orientation

- The "Cedi" is the currency of Ghana. We will discuss money exchange rate and how to count the money at our Pre-Orientation meeting.
- Smartphone apps provide calculation for current exchange rates.
- Large denominations of US currency (new \$50/\$100) yield a higher rate than using smaller bills. You can always exchange money at the hotels where you will be staying, but the rate is much less. Credit cards can be used in hotels and certain restaurants.

CELL PHONES

Cell phones, SIM cards, and local service will be discussed at the Pre-travel orientation.

PASSPORT & VISA INFORMATION

U.S. PASSPORTS

If you are a U.S. citizen, please find extensive information about obtaining a passport @ http://travel.state.gov/content/passports/english/passports/new.html

Please note that the routine processing time for a passport is 4-6 weeks. Expedited service is 3 weeks.

You can obtain proper passport photos from a wide variety of vendors including Costco, Staples, FedEx Kinkos, Walgreens, Rite-Aid, CVS, UPS Stores, Office Depot. The quality and costs vary.

The fees for first time applicants and renewal applicants are the same: \$140 (adult passport book & card) \$110 (adult passport book) \$30 (adult passport card)

Execution fees may apply depending upon your circumstances. You may calculate your fees at http://travel.state.gov/content/passports/english/passports/information/costs.html#EstimateCost

Please review the "Frequently Asked Questions" section to help with your particular needs.You may also find information about obtaining or renewing a U.S. passport at the U.S. Postal Service website https://www.usps.com/shop/apply-for-a-passport.htm

Please be wary of services that advertise you can get a passport in one-day.

As you prepare to travel, remember that each step requires a certain amount of time to complete. If you do not currently have a passport, please apply for it now. You may apply for your visa, once you have your airline ticket for Ghana.

ALL VISA APPLICANTS ARE STRONGLY ADVISED TO SUBMIT THEIR APPLICATIONS AND PASSPORTS FOR VISAS ONE TO TWO MONTHS PRIOR TO THE INTENDED DATE OF DEPARTURE.

NOTE: APPLICANTS MUST INCLUDE THEIR PASSPORTS AS PART OF THEIR APPLICATIONS, AS ALL VISAS, IF ISSUED, ARE INSERTED INTO THE PASSPORTS.

Types of Visas issued by the Embassy are:

- A1 Diplomatic Visa For Diplomatic passport Holders only (Gratis)
- A2 Official Visa For Official Passport Holders only (Gratis)
- B1 Business Visa For Business

B2- Tourism visa = For tourism, holidays and normal visits

- C Transit Visa For transit
- F1 Education Visa For students/study visits
- H1 Voluntary Work For work on voluntary basis.Conference
- G1 International Organizations For staff of recognized International Organizations
- 12 Press accreditation For media personnel undertaking an approved project

An applicant shall complete a visa application form in duplicates (2 copies) and attach **two (2) passport size photographs** which were taken not more than three (3) months from the date of submitting the application.

An applicant should possess a return air ticket, which should be submitted upon request, in the case of an application for tourist visa.

An application for an official, business and student visa shall be submitted together with a letter of invitation from the principals in Ghana and or in U.S.A.

Application for persons under eighteen (18) years shall be submitted together with the original birth certificate, with a letter of consent from the parent, and a copy of a parent's photo

In the case of journalist and or film crew who are covering an event or shooting a film in Ghana, the application shall take two weeks (14 days) for processing. In addition, such an applicant shall complete another form to indicate the nature of coverage and equipment to be taken to Ghana. Upon arrival in Ghana, such applicant shall call at the Information Services Department for accreditation.

When an application for a visa is turned down, the visa-issuing officer is not obliged to offer any explanation. An applicant may however re-apply for a review.

NOTE: APPLICANTS MUST INCLUDE THEIR PASSPORTS AS PART OF THEIR APPLICATIONS, AS ALL VISAS, IF ISSUED, ARE INSERTED INTO THE PASSPORTS.

Visa Fees

Money order, Cashier's check or Certified bank check made payable to the Embassy of Ghana. Note: Personal and company checks are not accepted.

Cash payments: Please do not mail cash.

ECOWAS citizens (Economic Community of West African States) Gratis

- ★ Single Entry Visa (must be used within 3 months from date of issue) \$60.00
- ★ Multiple Entry Visa \$100.00
- ★ Single Expedited \$100.00
- ★ Multiple Visa Expedited \$200.00

An expedited/emergency service will take **5 business days.** <u>NOTE:</u> If mailed a visa might take longer than twenty-four (24) hours to reach the applicant.

Visa application fees are non-refundable.



You will need to submit the following documents to obtain your visa

- ★ Completed visa application form.
- ★ You can complete a copy of the visa application form online. You must have Adobe Acrobat Reader to view and complete the form. You must print the form to complete the process.
- ★ Valid passport for at least six (6) months (Before Expiration)
- ★ Airline ticket
- ★ Evidence of financial support or letter of invitation from host in Ghana
- ★ Visa Fee money order, postal order, cashiers check or certified bank check
- ★ Two passport-size photographs of applicant. Should be taken at least within the last three months (Very Important)
- ★ Affix each photograph with glue on the top right comer of the application form.
- ★ Applications submitted by mail must be accompanied by prepaid self-addressed overnight, trackable envelope (FEDEX) for return of passports. Only requests accompanied by certified prepaid return envelopes will be processed.

- b. Two (1) passport size photographs. (FULL Face view on White background)
- c. Flight itinerary
- d. Self addressed prepaid USPS/FEDEX/UPS envelope with tracking number for return of passport (see mail restrictions)Mail or drop-off passport and all other documents listed above. Failure to include all items could lead to delays in processing of your visa.

Please note:

- a. There is a waiting period of ten(10) working days for Visa processing.
- b. Applicants are advised to apply within two weeks of their travel date.
- c. Airlines by regulation, will not allow you to board without a valid visa.
- d. If you are a Liberian, living in the United States and have become a US citizen, you are required to obtain a valid visa to travel to Liberia
